The following information is now reported with respect to the present activities of some of the leading personalities connected with the I.S.H.+ movement.

1. Ernst WOLLWEBER. (Vide our [] of 1.11.33)

This man is still in Copenhagen. It is not yet certain if he will be transferred to the main office, which is now in Antwerp.

2. Adolf SHELLEY (Vide our [] of 13.2.34)

This man is in France working amongst the French Trades Unions for the purpose of making propaganda for the Congress of the International Transport Federation, which is due to be held in September 1934. It is uncertain if much success will attend his efforts because, although he is an excellent organiser, he has only a poor knowledge of the French language.

3. Ernst RICHTER

4. Albert WALTER (Vide our [] of 17.3.34)

Still in Hamburg. He is obliged to report to the "Gestapo" daily. He has been informed that if he flees from Germany his relatives, and particularly his aged mother, will be arrested and sent to a concentration camp. It is therefore considered unlikely that he will take advantage of any offer which may be made to him to leave Germany.

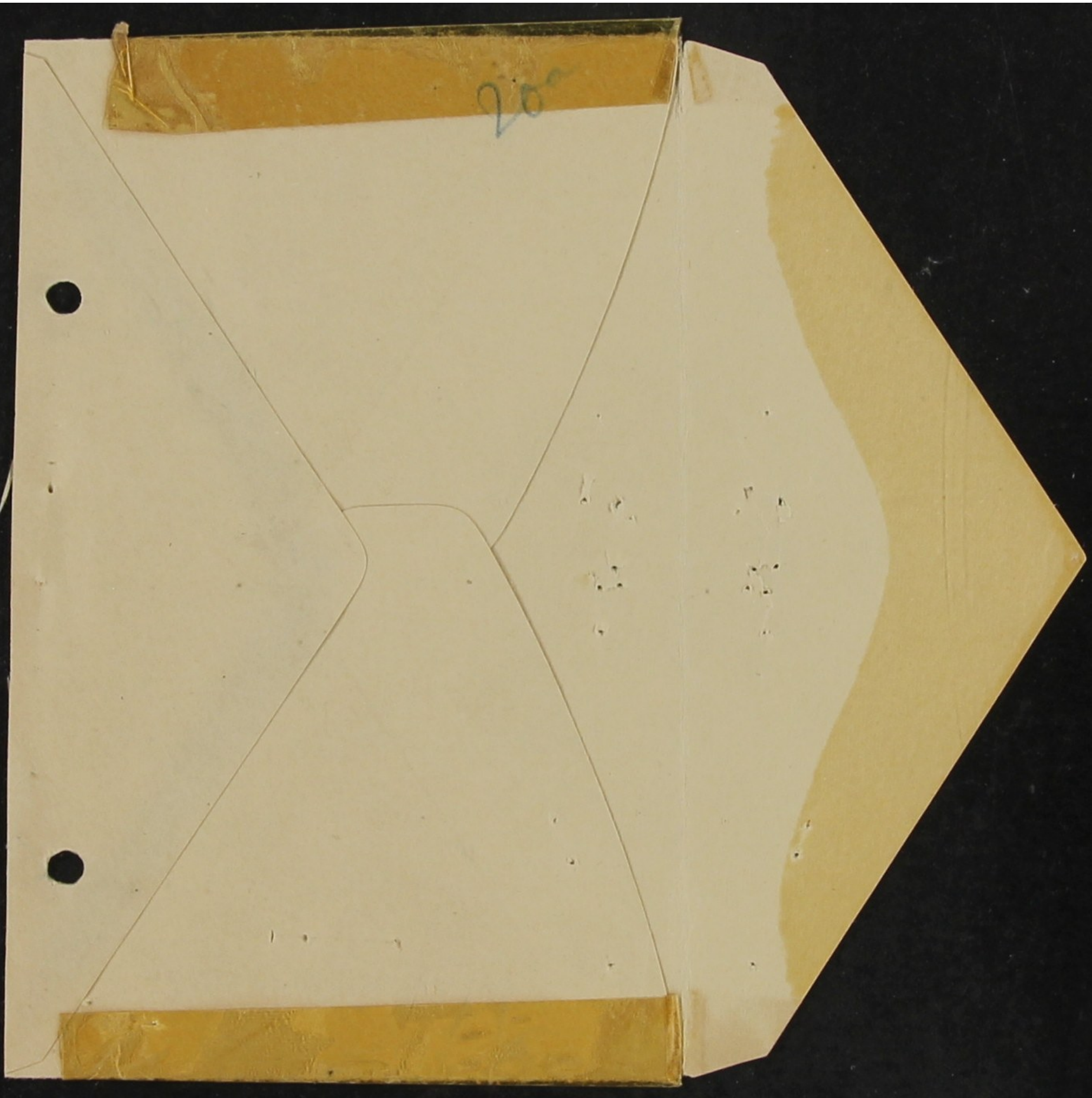



We are informed that he arrived in Rotterdam from Copenhagen on 10.8.33 and that he had a meeting with the Secretariat of the local Communist Party on the same day, with regard to ensuring the safety of the International Seamen's Club in view of police raids. Decisions were also come to on the Party campaign in the press, in parliament, meetings, demonstrations, etc. This journey is, of course, in pursuance of the inspection tour referred to in paragraph two of my letter under reference.

Dear Holderness,

A German named Ernst WOLLENWEBER or WOLLWEBER is the German representative of the International of Seamen and Harbour Workers in Copenhagen, and is now working in the illegal headquarters of the Communist Party there. Although he is by nationality a German, he has been supplied with a Danish passport in the name of CHRISTIANSEN, which gives his occupation as that of a stoker and his date of birth as 1895. The attached photograph, taken at the Congress of the International of Seamen and Harbour Workers at Hamburg in May 1932, is believed to be that on his Danish passport in the name of CHRISTIANSEN; it is understood that this passport is stamped Fredriksberg-Politi.

Reliable information has been received that in August he is going on an inspection tour of all continental ports, exclusive of Germany where he would be known. It is thought probable that he will try to visit the United Kingdom, as he has been pressing the secretariat of the International of Seamen and Harbour Workers to insist on increased activity in their British section, the Seamen's Minority Movement.

Should this individual come to this country, he could only be doing so in order to indulge in undesirable activities, and I would suggest that his name might be added to the list of those persons circulated for exclusion in May 1933 (see your 659008/6 of 25.5.33). If you decide on a circular and require the usual 40 copies of the photograph, would you please let me know.

He proposes going, or has already gone, to Copenhagen via Sassnitz, Trelleborg and Malmö. He has a Danish passport, as reported in our previous letter, but the date of birth has been altered from 1905 to 1895.

It is also stated that Moscow instructed [SHELLY,] through KOBETZKI, Soviet Minister in Denmark, to invite WOLLENWEBER to join the Secretariat of the I.S.H., as it was considered essential to have a German in it (in this connexion please see our [redacted] dated 28.6.33.).

To point 5. It was resolved to send a comrade to Hamburg with instructions to endeavour to reorganise communications with Hamburg. It was resolved, ~~to~~ further, to send WOLLENWEBER to Copenhagen in order to establish a new activity committee. The Secretariat promised to arrange the necessary finances before the end of May so that work could be carried out in Hamburg undisturbed.

To point 7. WOLLENWEBER was instructed to appoint German comrades to the ports of Rotterdam, Antwerp, Amsterdam, Esbjerg, Rouen, Marseille, London and Cardiff, as functionaries for propaganda among German sailors, and to collect their subscriptions.

To point 9. The financing of Hamburg which was being done through WOLLENWEBER was to be reorganised as soon as possible.
